ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR COACHES

CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK

Community coaches, as with all volunteers who work with students at Langley Christian, are required to have a criminal record check completed. The process of completing a criminal record involves taking a [signed CRC request letter](#) from LCS and going to the Murrayville RCMP or municipal police detachment in which you reside. A criminal records check is considered valid if it was issued 5 years or earlier from the current date.

BC SCHOOL SPORT MANDATORY CONCUSSION TRAINING

BCSS policy mandates concussion training for all coaches, teacher sponsors, trainers, and team managers. Certifications must be done through CATT and are valid for 2 years before needing re-certification. The 30-45 minutes course can be found at www.cattonline.com/coach-course/.
