All ELL assessments are completed by the International Department.

- 1. Initial Assessments
 - (a) Grades 6-12
 - 1.a.1. Incoming students for grade 6-12 complete the iTEP Slate Plus online exam: (https://www.itepexam.com/products/itep-slate/)
 - 1.a.2. Scores of 1, 2, or 3 indicate that ELL support will be required (this may be in the form of individual or small group settings)
 - 1.a.3. Scores of 4 and above indicate that ELL support will not be required
 - (b) Kindergarten Grade 5
 - 1.b.1. Students are assessed on a 1:1 basis in reading, writing, listening and speaking as language level and age allows
 - 1.b.2. Several tools are used depending on the specific context. These include:
 - The ERGO assessment
 - o A short interview (asking questions such as name, age, favourite things to do, etc...)
 - o A writing sample (this may be a few sentences or a longer paragraph, depending on ability)
 - o Fountas & Pinnell readings as appropriate, depending on age and language level
 - 1.b.3. Support is offered either on a 1:1 basis or in small group settings
- 2. Ongoing Assessments:
 - (c) Students are assessed on an ongoing basis and in consultation with their classroom teachers
 - (d) ELL Coordinator regularly meets with classroom teachers to discuss any adaptations required to assist the ELL Students in comprehension and inclusion.
 - (e) Ongoing assessments include: evaluating the progress of unedited written work, reading and vocabulary comprehension, general and detailed comprehension in listening and speaking
