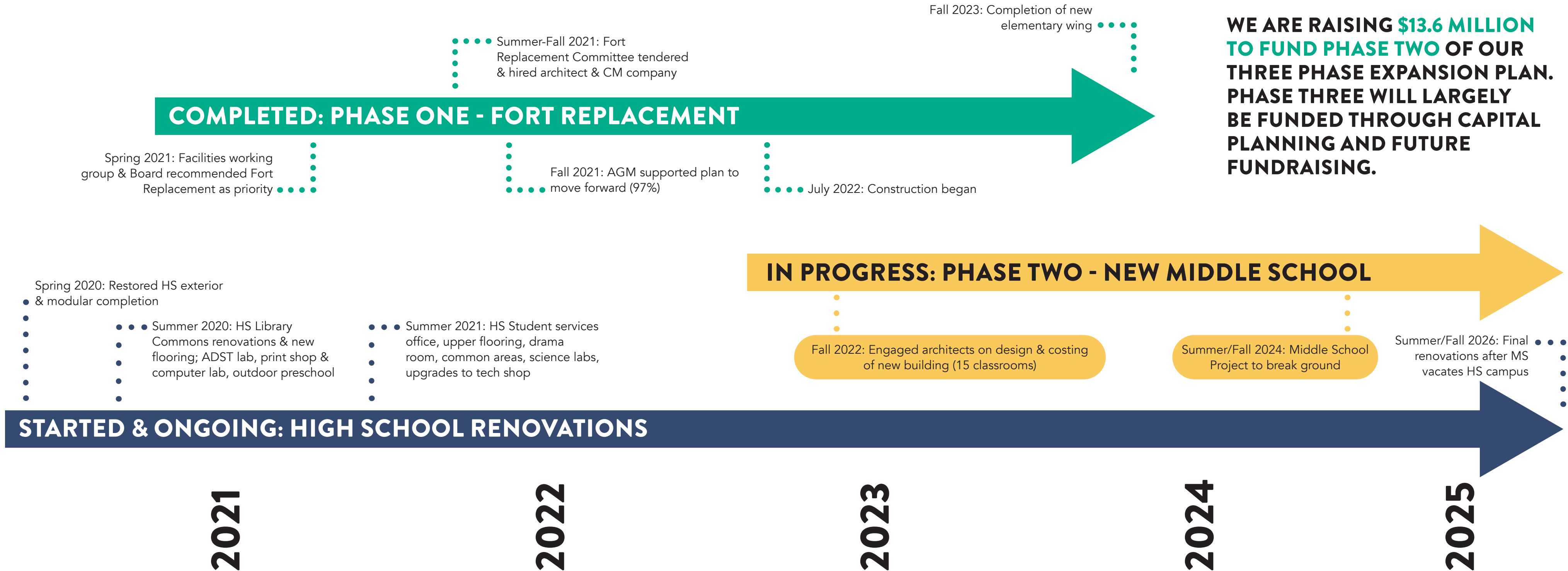

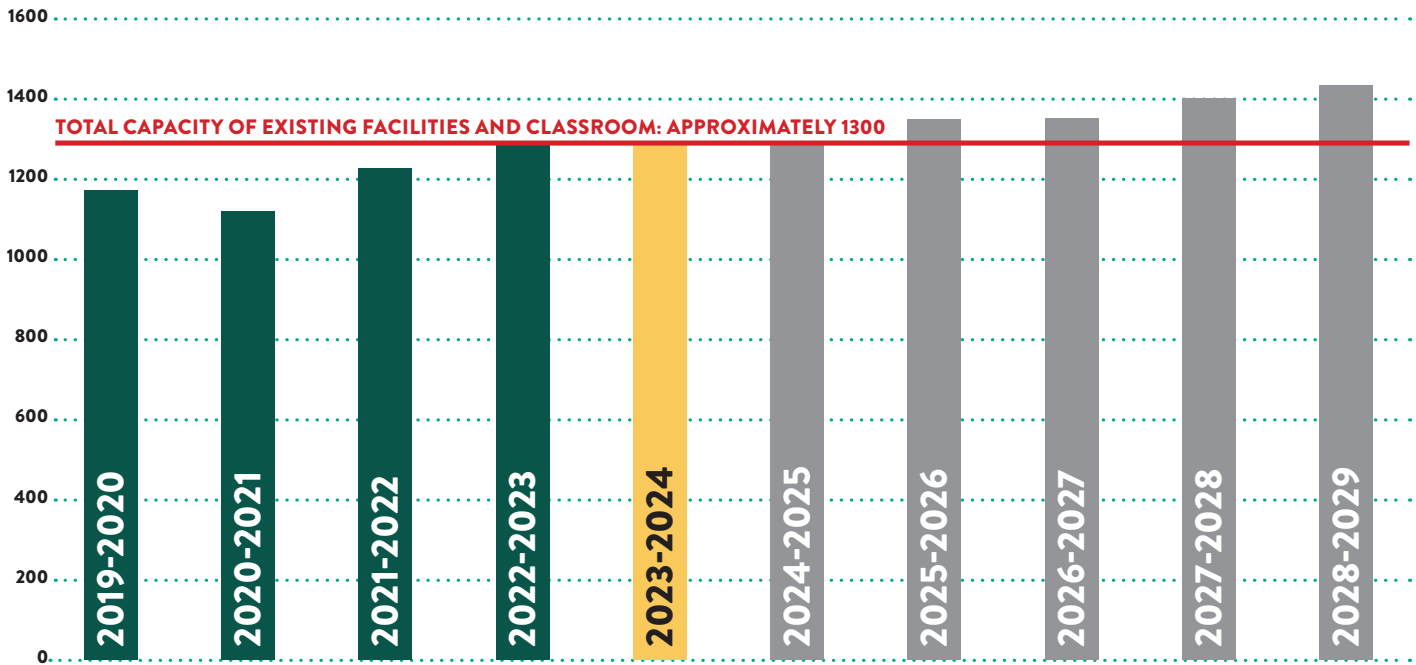

MIDDLE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL

“The high school trades program is so big now we can’t get middle school students into those classrooms anymore. One day last year, I had to fight my way down a very busy hallway.

I realized we have one unused space in the middle school wing - the upper hallway. So, we purchased shelves, portable work benches and hand tools to provide woodworking in the last usable space in the whole building. Now our upper hallway is a woodworking classroom. Not ideal. It’s a great example of how we’ve outgrown our space.”

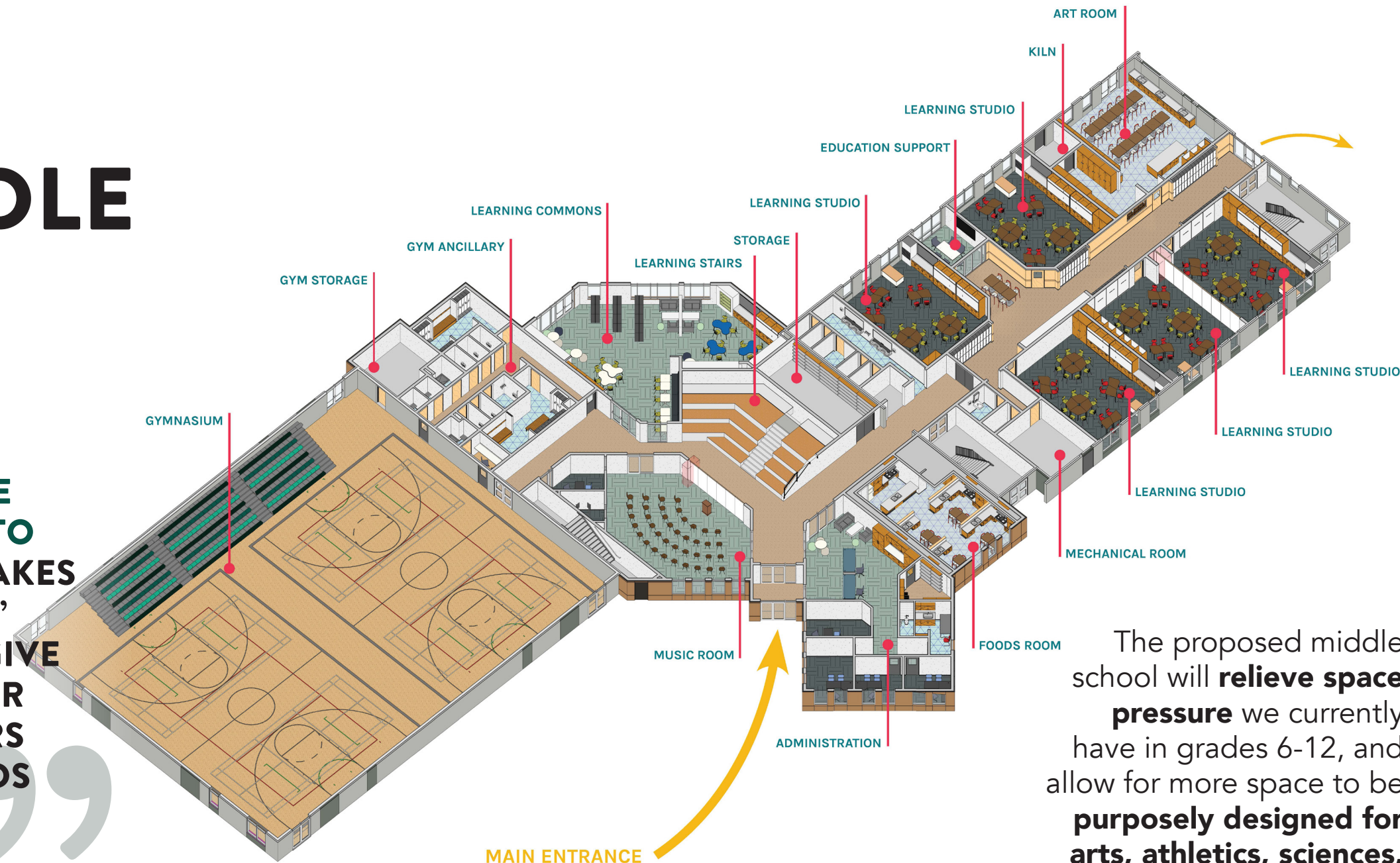

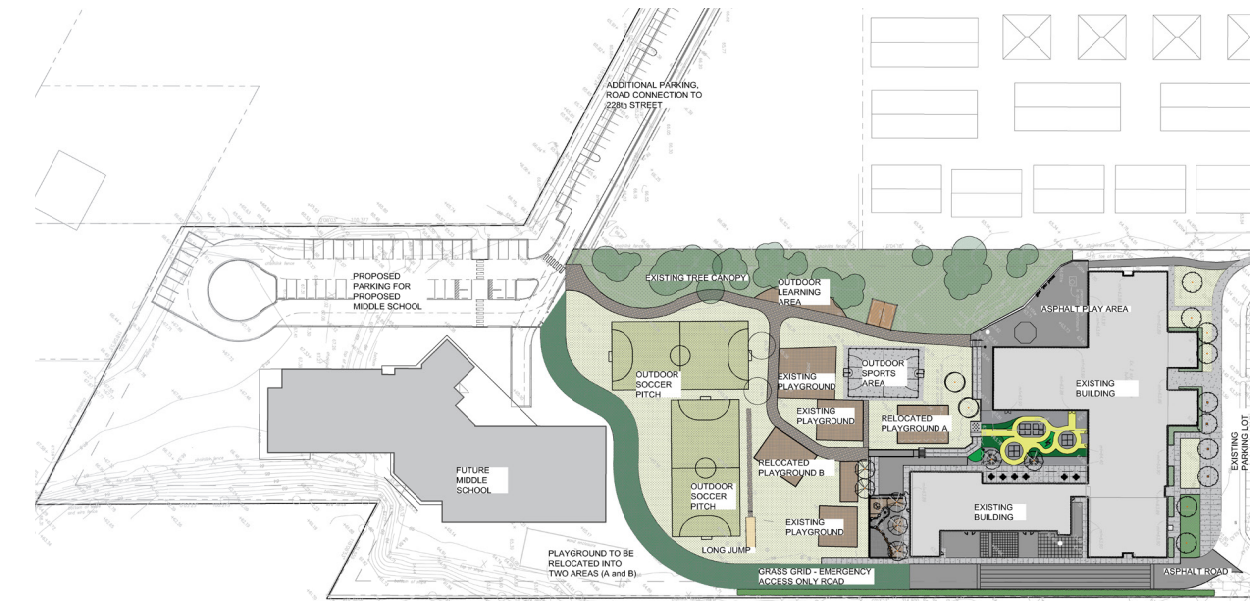
PHASE 2: NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL

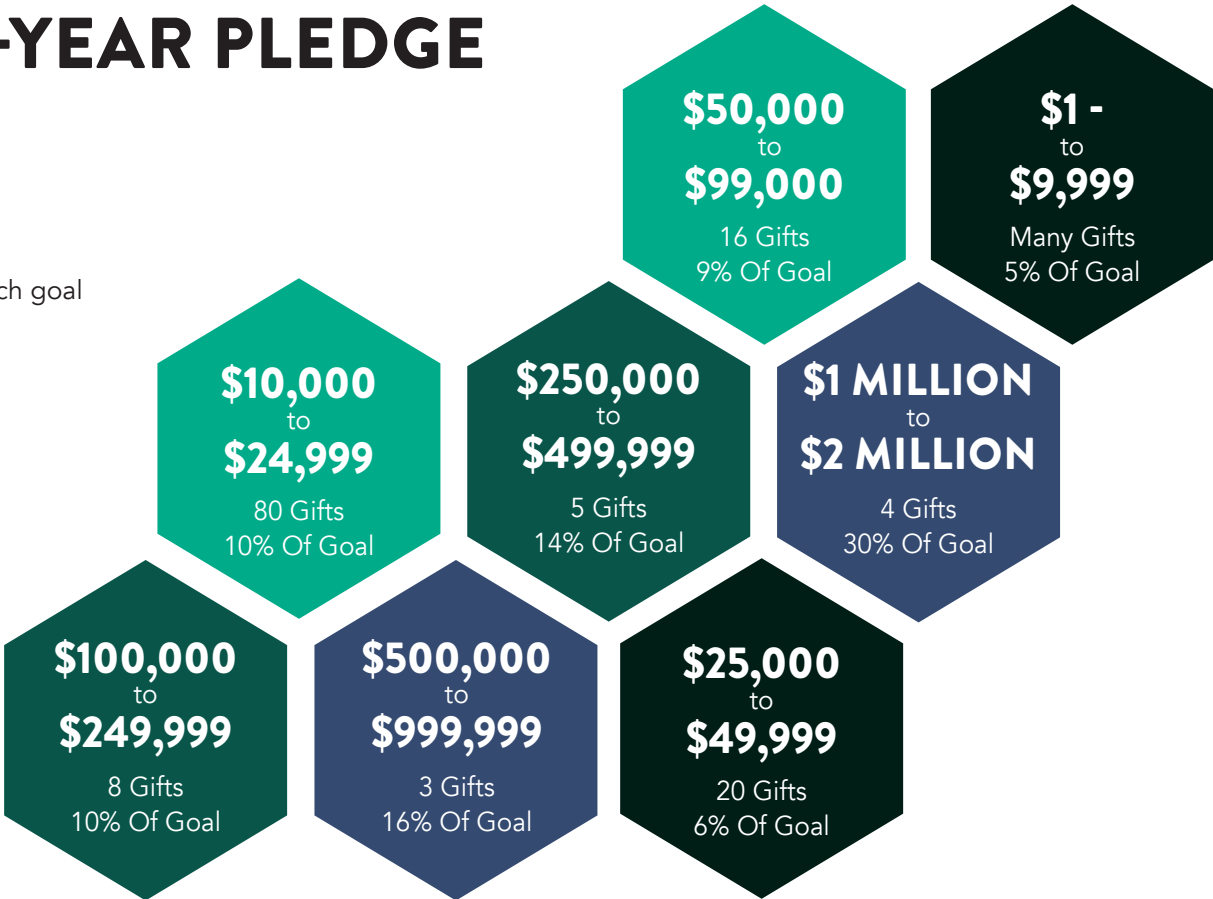

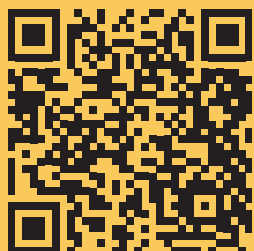
