- In-depth knowledge of and demonstrated ability to apply the BC Ministry of Education's current philosophy, teaching practices, and evaluation/assessment/reporting procedures as outlined in the *Manual of Policies, Procedures, and Guidelines for Special Education Services*.
- Proficiency in analyzing and utilizing various forms of student data to set targets and develop responsive student plans.
- Proven ability to collaborate effectively with school-based team members and staff to support instruction and interventions for students with disabilities or diverse abilities, including a strong foundation in instructional and assessment practices for all students.
- Experience in developing, implementing, and monitoring IEPs, progress reporting, and strength-based planning, including student-led IEPs and strategies that foster student independence.
