## MONITORING AND EVALUATION

The Director of Learning Support Services in Conjunction with representatives of the Accessibility Planning Committee will meet (quarterly) to review progress and evaluate the effectiveness of the plan's implementation and plan for increased accessibility throughout the school.

Strategic Leadership Team meetings will include a regular review of the plan as part of its overarching LCS Strategic Plan review.

The committee will ensure the following steps are taken regarding the Three-Year Accessibility Plan:

- Prepare an annual status report on the progress of the measures taken to implement the plan, which will be delivered or presented to the Head of School and Board of Directors no later than June 30 each year.
- 2. Review and update the Three-Year Accessibility Plan every three years in consultation with persons with disabilities and other relevant community members.

All recommendations of the Accessibility Planning Committee will be reviewed by the SLT and/or appropriate Board standing committees and subject to the established policies and procedures of the Board of Directors, including but not limited to financial approval and capital planning.

Any recommendations of the Accessibility Planning Committee will be annually reviewed by the Head of School and Board of Directors for consideration in the LCS Strategic Plan.
